



Joint Proclamation



WHEREAS; The City of Bellingham and Whatcom County recognize the importance of helping children find permanent, safe and loving families through adoption; and

WHEREAS; more than 113,000 children in the United States foster care system are waiting to be adopted; and

WHEREAS; 6,957 children in Washington state are in foster care, with 1,065 legally free to be adopted; and

WHEREAS; outreach to adoptive families has been identified as a critical step in moving children more quickly out of foster care and into loving, permanent homes; and

WHEREAS; to help these children find new homes, the Whatcom County Superior Court on November 17, 2023 will celebrate adoptions and the parents who welcome these children into their families;

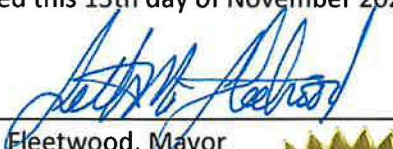
WHEREAS; this effort, along with similar celebrations across the country, will offer children a chance to live with stable and loving families and encourage other adults to consider making a powerful difference in the life of a child through adoption.
