













Figure 10. Frequency of watching BTV10. (n=419)




Figure 11. How often were you tuning in to watch a City Council meeting? (n=295)





Figure 12. Frequency of visiting cob.org. (n=326)




Findings: Environment



Figure 16. Neighborhood ratings





Figure 17. Ratings of neighborhood streets, sorted by ratings of *excellent*
