I live where Mill and 11th street meet, on the third floor of Judson Plaza. I have lost a good portion of my view of the Bay due to the variance given to Village Books, a variance not given to Sharon Grimsman when she built Judson Plaza.

A 66' tall building in the "hole" North of Village Books would remove what remains of my view of Bellingham Bay. Sixty six feet is taller than population density projections require.

In general, I believe the proposed height restrictions would swamp Historic Fairhaven and turn it into merely another high rise suburb, with little historic value. I oppose any height restrictions greater than those mandated by your population projections.

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
