Subject: Update to Fairhaven Neighborhood and Urban Village project schedule

Hello Fairhaven Stakeholders, Project Team, City Council and Mayor Linville -

We have a few revisions to our public meeting schedule for this project that I would like to share with you. Please note them on your calendars:

1. **The January 18<sup>th</sup> MNAC (Mayor's Neighborhood Advisory Commission) meeting was cancelled due to inclement weather.** Staff has rescheduled the Fairhaven overview presentation for MNAC's March 21st meeting (see #5., below).
2. **The Historic Preservation Commission meeting remains as scheduled for Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 p.m., Council Chambers.** Staff will respond to questions and comments raised by commissioners at their 1/10/12 meeting regarding the Draft Fairhaven Urban Village Design Standards; Draft Development Regulations; and Draft Design Review Process.
3. **The Transportation Commission meeting remains as scheduled for Tuesday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 - 8:00 p.m., Council Chambers.** Focus will be on the Transportation Chapter and parking. Transportation Commissioners will be asked for comment and a letter of recommendation.
4. **An additional Public Input Session will be held Thursday, February 16<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 - 8:30 p.m., Council Chambers.** This session will be recorded, and provides an opportunity for stakeholders to give feedback on the [Draft Neighborhood and Urban Village Plan](#), [Draft Design Standards](#), [Draft Development Regulations](#), and [Draft Design Review Process](#) posted on the City website for public review on December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011. Staff will provide a brief overview of the various plans and proposals, with the remainder of the meeting spent listening to the public and answering questions.
5. **MNAC meeting March 21st, 6:30 p.m., Mayor's Board Room.** An overview of the draft planning documents will be presented. MNAC will be asked for comment and a letter of recommendation.
6. **Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 p.m., Council Chambers.** Final draft documents will be made available to the public on the City website no less than 1 month prior to the hearing. Staff will provide an overview of significant changes between the preliminary draft issued December 21st and the final draft.
