  - o Birchwood neighborhood multi family density is 6 units/acre, 5<sup>th</sup> highest in Bellingham
  - o 14.6% of Birchwood Neighborhood are disabled, versus 12.7% for Washington as a whole
  - o 50%-59% of Birchwood Neighborhood residents are low income
