Guiding Principles

- Address Current Needs Preventative maintenance preserves valuable community asset and keeps costs low.
- Look for Opportunities Leverage maintenance needs or new requirements to upgrade and enhance.
- Identify High Value Upgrades Relatively lowcost upgrades that will increase visitors and revenue.


Mount Baker Theatre

- Repair, Maintenance and Replacement
 - Roofs Five roofs to be replaced
 - Electrical Outdated wiring, panels, lighting, controls
 - HVAC Replacement of multiple RTU's, controls
 - ADA Compliance Updates to meet current requirements



Mount Baker Theatre

- Options and Enhancements
 - Replacement of Seating Improve customer experience and comfort
 - Electrical Upgrade to stage lighting standards to reflect modern standards/expectations
 - Security Increase safety and speed of ingress





Whatcom Museum, Lightcatcher Building

- Repair, Maintenance and Replacement
 - HVAC Humidity control, heating, cooling all at end of life
 - Electrical Replacement of lighting at front entrance
 - Light Wall Glass failure, water and pest intrusion
 - Floors Refinishing throughout
 - Collections Storage Area Complete construction to maintain and protect museum collection



Whatcom Museum, Lightcatcher Building

- Options and Enhancements
 - Covered Loading/Unloading Dock Ensure museum meets accreditation standards to attract exceptional exhibitions
 - Lighting Signage and Exterior Façade Increase value of building to surrounding streetscape and community awareness/curiosity
 - FIG Renovation Reinvigorate and modernize

Estimated Financial Need

- Mount Baker Theatre \$13 million
- Lightcatcher Museum \$7 Million
- Notes
 - Rough order of magnitude estimates in 2024 dollars.
 - City performing studies in the first quarter of 2025 that will provide more detailed scope and cost estimates
