





Sales Tax Nominal vs. Real Revenue





Sales Tax by NAICS Subsector – Top 5




Lodging Tax (Hotel/Motel Tax)

- Restricted revenue for tourism activities




Permit and Housing Market Activity







Citywide Revenues and Expenses



Citywide Revenue - \$196m




Citywide Expenses - \$213m

- Revenues restricted or committed for specific purposes


Revenue = \$43.2m Expenses = \$50.6m



Enterprise Funds

- Business-type activities that are self sustainable with user fees


Revenue = \$54.7m Expenses = \$60.8m




Internal Service Funds

- Business-type activities that provide goods and services to City departments


Revenue = \$36.4m Expenses = \$43.6m




General Fund Revenues - \$61.3m




General Fund Expenditures - \$60.9m
