

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between City Of Bellingham And

Washington State Council of County And City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO Local 114

## CONTRACTING WITH PRIVATE CONTRACTORS FOR CLEAN-UP OF HOMELESS CAMPS

- PURPOSE: This Memorandum of Understanding outlines the mutual understanding between the parties regarding the use of private contractors for homeless camp clean ups on City property and right-of-ways.
- II. SCOPE: This agreement allows the use of private contractors for specialized homeless camp cleanup work on City owned land and right-of-ways. This agreement does not preclude the City from assigning homeless camp clean up to employees as needed.

## III. AGREEMENT:

WHEREAS, the City regularly performs homeless camp cleanup work on City property and right-of-ways;

WHEREAS, the City seeks to use private contractors for the more challenging homeless camp cleanup work requiring safe work practices and biohazard removal and disposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree that:

- Private contractors will used for the majority of homeless camp clean ups.
- The use of private contractors for homeless camp cleanup work will not result in any reduction of AFSCME 114 positions.
- Employees will conduct homeless camp clean ups as needed; however, their priority will be their core duties relating to parks and street maintenance.
