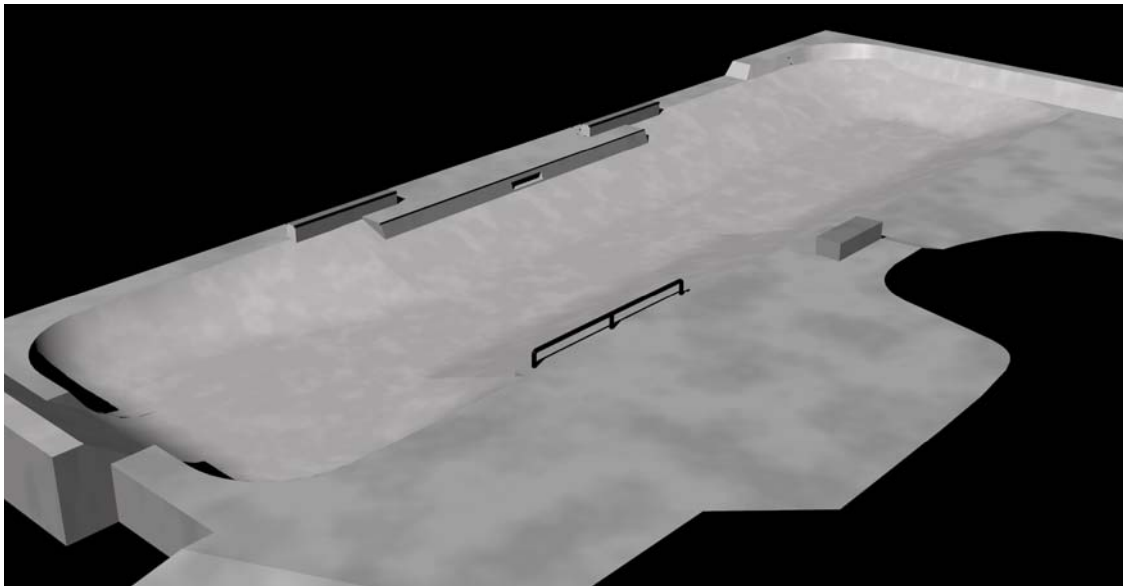

Grindline has chosen to revise the street course design for the Bellingham Phase 2 skatepark. We have taken opportunity of the fact that bidding has been delayed for over a year on this project to update the design.
