### Project Overview: ES-0531

The project includes bike lanes, sidewalks, planter strip, curb, gutter and streetlights. The purpose is to provide the retrofit of Aldrich Road to provide access to all users, including bicyclists, pedestrians, motorists and public transportation riders. In particular, to provide better access to the Cordata Elementary School.

Funding from Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) for \$500,000. Federal Safe Route to School for \$103,000.
