Bellingham Police Department Update, Chief Mertzig

Chief Mertzig gave an update from the past 8 months of her employment. She commented on staffing challenges and cooperation with other jurisdictions. Chief answered questions on her vision for the future, mental health needs, safety in schools, legislation, jail, Blake Decision, and homelessness.
