Northridge Detention Pond Retrofit



Project Description

Northridge Detention Pond Retrofit project originally started as a storm water treatment enhancement project to be constructed on a city parcel along Barkley Blvd. Certain aspects of the parcel were deemed poor for the proposed treatment facility so a land exchange was brokered with the North Shore Hills Community Association such that an adjacent existing pond could increase in size to accommodate a sand filtration system instead. This facility currently provides basic storm water treatment for approximately 38 acres of city and county developed residential area within the Lake Whatcom watershed. The proposed facility meets both enhanced and phosphorus treatment requirements per the Department of Ecology Storm Water Management Manual.
