# JOB SUMMARY:

Works with, and assists in the maintenance and construction of trails and open space in the Bellingham Park system. May work with structures crew on various projects, including surfaces projects.

- 4. Performs manual labor such as digging, shoveling, raking, lifting, and pushing a wheelbarrow.
- 5. Operates a variety of automotive equipment including pickup trucks and dump trucks.
- 6. Operates and maintains a variety of shop and portable power tools.
- 7. Cleans and repairs trail bridges and steps as needed.
- 8. Maintains records dealing with trail maintenance activities.
- 9. Performs other duties as assigned.
