MEETING PURPOSE:

The meeting will focus the 30% site design plans. The plans are grounded on the park master plan, adopted by the City Council September 2017. Phase one development includes wide range of amenities, such as: a spray park, playground, parkour area, bicycle pump track, adult exercise, large picnic shelter, trail loops, restroom building, open playfield, pedestrian gateways into the park, landscape planting, parking area, cross walks, and other uses.

The Parks and Recreation Department welcomes residents to attend the Jan. 10 meeting to review the plans, especially those living in the Cordata and Meridian neighborhoods. BACKGROUND:

The City acquired the new 20 acre park in 2015 with voter approved Greenways 3 Levy funds. The park is located on the east side of Cordata Parkway between Stuart and Horton Roads, in the Cordata Neighborhood.
