#### **Eligibility**

**Community Development Advisory Board** – There are four (4) vacancies on the Board. Meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month at 6:00 p.m. in the Mayor's Board Room at City Hall.

**Historic Preservation Commission** - There are four (4) vacancies on the commission. Meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 4:00 p.m. and the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in City Council Chambers at City Hall.

**Immigration Advisory Board** – There are four (4) vacancies on the board. Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 6:30 pm.

**Parks & Recreation Advisory Board** – There are two (2) vacancies on the board (student representative 1 year term and a community representative with regular term). Meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month at 7:30 a.m. in the Mayor's Board Room, City Hall.

**Public Facilities District** – There are three (3) vacancies on the board. Meets the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the month every three months at 11:00 a.m. in the Law Library at City Hall, 210 Lottie Street. \*County residents welcome to apply.



**Sehome Hill Arboretum** - There is one (1) vacancy. Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month (excluding June, July and August) at 4:00 p.m. at the WWU Physical Plant, 915 26th Street.

**Sister Cities Advisory Board** - There are five (5) vacancies on the board. Meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month in January, April, July, and October at 5:30 p.m. in the Mayor's Board Room, City Hall. \*County residents welcome to apply.

**Tourism Commission** – There is one (1) vacancy on the Commission. The Commission meets the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month at 3:00 p.m. \*County residents welcome to apply.

**Transportation Commission** - There is one (1) vacancy on the Commission. Meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. in the Mayor's Board Room, 210 Lottie Street \*County residents welcome to apply.

Water Resources Advisory Board – There are nine (9) vacancies on this new Board. Meets six times per year with special meetings being held as the board deems necessary. Location is yet to be determined.
