

Carl Cozier Safe Routes to School Safety Improvements

Project Overview: ES-0477

Improvements include:

- Construction of a raised sidewalk with curb, gutter, and ADA ramps along the north side of Gladstone St.
- Installation of a sidewalk bulb out, marked crosswalks, school zone flashing beacons and ADA accessible curb ramps at the intersection of Lincoln St. and Potter St.
- Installation of two bike racks on-site at Carl Cozier Elementary School.

The Safe Routes to School Program is a partnership with Bellingham Public Works and Police Departments, Bellingham School District, Whatcom County Health Department, and everybodyBIKE. The intent of the project is to increase the number of students safely walking and bicycling to Carl Cozier Elementary School. The majority of this project is federally funded as part of the Safe Routes to School program, with additional matching funds provided by the City of Bellingham. This project is also partially funded with Transportation Benefit District No. 1 funds.
