

State and Laurel Street Pedestrian Safety Improvements

Project Overview: ES-0492

To improve pedestrian access and safety across North State Street, this project consists of sidewalk construction, marked crosswalks, ADA facilities, improved drainage, curb extensions (bulb-outs) and improved signage at the intersection of North State and East Laurel streets. The majority of funding for this project comes from the Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The project is also partially funded with Transportation Benefit District No. 1 dollars at work. The project will also include new sidewalk construction along East Laurel Street from North State to the South Bay Trail.

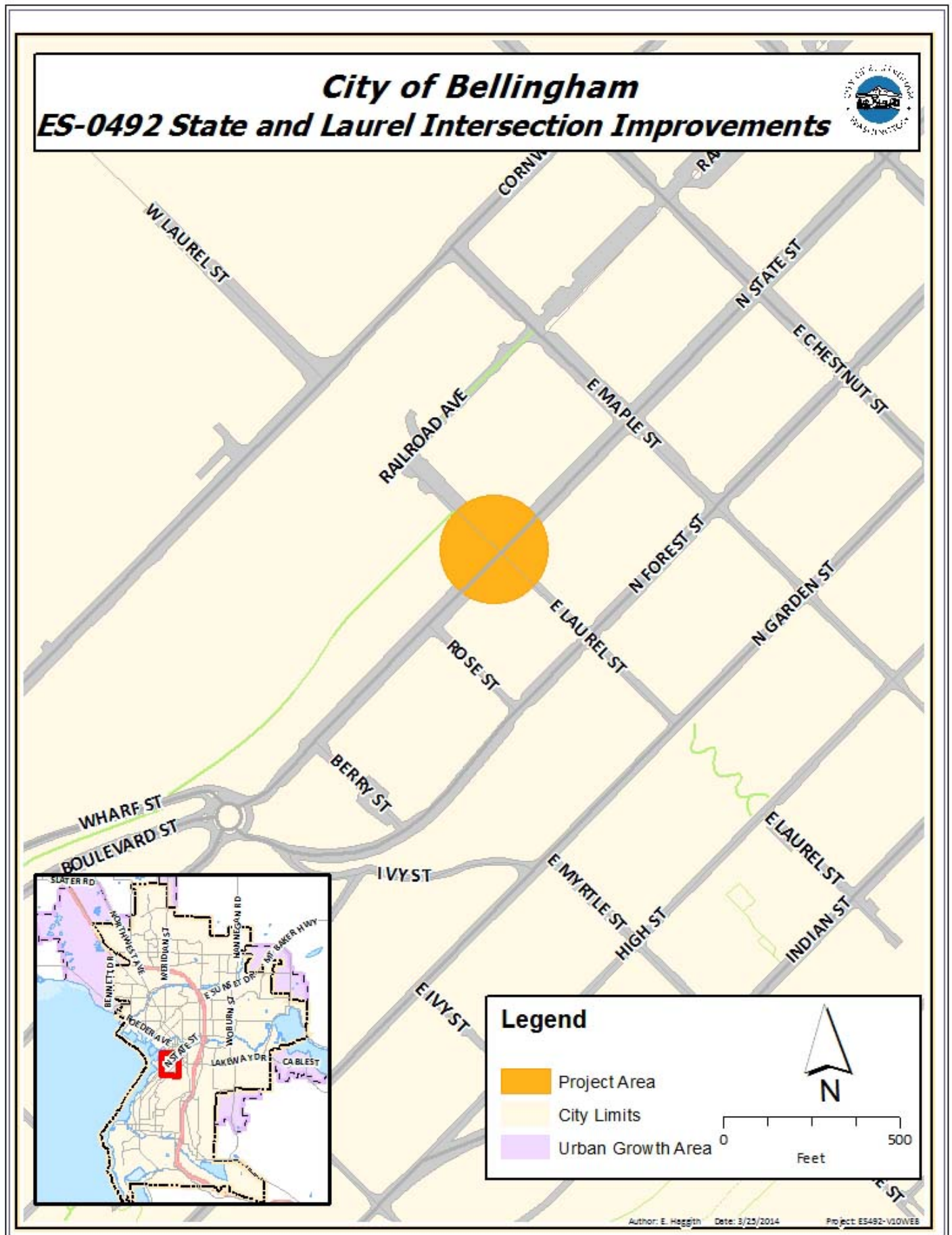
