Includes \$39.8 million in King Mountain Neighborhood transportation improvements, as follows:

- **\$12.2 million** for Orchard-Birchwood Extension (2020);
 - **\$5.8 million** for Telegraph Road Improvements (2021);
 - **\$4.0 million** for James/Bakerview Roundabout (2023);
 - **\$3.6 million** for North James Street extension (on-going) constructed by private developers; and
 - **\$14.2 million** estimated for 'preferred alternative' James Street transportation improvements (2024+).

(\$8.5 million invested in James Street Bridge, corridor, and intersection improvements 2013-2016)
