Geranium robertianum

Herb-Robert is an invasive, non-native plant introduced into the United States from Europe. It is both a winter and spring annual or biennial that reproduces by ejecting seeds when it dries. It can eject seeds as far as 15-20 feet, rapidly taking over a garden and forcing out other plants. Herb-Robert has small pink flowers Spring through Fall and fern-like leaves. This plant is classified as a noxious weed in Western Washington.
